Description:

Cirkoscopik is an outdoor show for all audiences, inspired by clowns of the 19th and 20th century. The two characters try to find the symphony that binds them together through acrobatics, live music and clumsiness.

Performance area/stage (Adaptable depending on the available site):

Ideal space: 16 feet (5 meters) wide | 23 feet (7 meters) long

Ideal height: 15 feet (4,5 meters)

Floor: Smooth and level - street, asphalt, concrete, grass

Temperature: To prevent injuries to performers and for the comfort of the audience, a minimum temperature of 15 degrees Celsius and a maximum temperature of 35 degrees Celsius is required.

Build-up:

Minimum 2 hours: cleaning for the safety of the artists and warm-up on the stage, take into account 30 minutes for the build-down.

Scenography :

Provided by Cirkoscopik :

- Set, accessories, circus props and costumes
- Instruments (2 trumpets and an accordion)
- A rope to limit the performance area

Provided by the organizer:

- Welcome team
- Quiet environment during the performance to preserve the intimacy of the show
- Comfortable space for the audience
- Benches, chairs for the audience (if needed)
- 1 broom
- 1 sound amplifier with a 1/8 cable

Duration, artists and number of performances:

35 minutes without intermission

2 artists on stage

2 performances maximum per day (1 hour between each)

Dressing room:

Provided by the organizer:

- 1 modest, clean dressing room that can accommodate 2 performers
- A technician or volunteer is required to be present while the artists change and prepare in the dressing room (45 minutes before the start of the performance) and to supervise the artistic equipment between performances
- 1 bathroom with sink not accessible to the audience
- 1 complete first aid kit
- 2 bags of ice in case of injury
- Drinking water, fruit, nuts, tea, coffee, etc.

Cirkoscopik is committed to an eco-responsible approach, and we prohibit the use of single-use items. We recommend using a tap to fill our reusable bottles. The use of reusable towels in the bathrooms and on stage is also recommended.
